

Transmales who have sex with males (TMSM) are an emerging HIV risk population. The HIV Prevention Section (HPS) and the HIV Prevention Planning Council (HPPC) are committed to address the HIV prevention needs of this population. In its 2010 HIV Prevention Plan the HPPC puts forth several culturally appropriate recommendations for addressing the prevention needs of TMSM.
